Swissdox@LiRI is designed for **big data analyses**. The platform allows for **keyword search queries** and **returns**, as output, every article in full text which contains the searched (partial) terms. The data can then be downloaded and further processed and analyzed, enabling the handling of a broad spectrum of interdisciplinary as well as discipline-specific research questions.
